

Questions to ask University Representatives

- 1) What classes do I need to take for my major?
- 2) After I finish the IGETC (General Education Transfer Curriculum), is there more classes I have to take?
- 3) When do I apply for transfer?
- 4) How do I transfer?
- 5) If I took other classes at another Community College, does it count as part of my General Education?
- 6) Does participating and/or completing the Honors Program give me a better chance of getting accepted?
- 7) Is my major competitive? Do many students apply?
- 8) What can increase my chances of getting accepted?
- 9) Do all the UC's or Cal State's have the same pre-requisites?
- 10) How long will it take for me to graduate after I transfer?
- 11) What classes do I have to take if I want to apply for a UC/CSU/Private University.
- 12) Does your university accept mid year transfer? (winter/spring)
- 13) What is the average GPA for my major? .
- 14) Do the pre-requisites change every year?
- 15) Does it affect me if I have a "W" on my transcript?
- 16) If I am active in school activities and/or do community service, will it increase my chances of getting accepted?
- 17) Can I change my major once I transfer?
- 18) Do I need to complete all my major requirements in order to be admitted?
- 19) When will I hear about my financial aid?
- 20) After I apply when will I receive notification of my admission?
- 21) Will I have the opportunity to meet with a counselor after I have been admitted?
- 22) How will I know what classes to take after I transfer?
- 23) How can I learn more about housing? What are my options?
- 24) When should I send my transcripts?

Note: Ask the questions that appeal to you most, and feel free to ask any other lingering questions not on this list.
