UNIT REQUIREMENTS:

- ♦ To obtain a Bachelor's degree, most majors of study will require you to complete at least 120 semester units. *Please note that some majors will require more.*
- ♦ Most UC and Cal State schools require that you complete 60 units prior to entering the university as a junior (upper division status). *Note: students with less than 60 units are considered lower division applicants.*

MAJOR REQUIREMENTS:

- ♦ The subject requirements you can take at Chaffey include general education and major preparation courses. You can use the assist website (www.assist.org) to help guide you to take courses for your major at Chaffey College that are transferable to specific UC and Cal State schools.

TRANSFER ADMISSIONS:

- ♦ Transfer admissions are based on a combination of units, minimum grade point average, and completion of specific courses required for the school you are applying to.
- ♦ Required GPA
 - Minimum GPA to apply to UC for CA residents: 2.4; non-residents: 2.8
 - Minimum GPA to apply to CSU for CA residents: 2.0; non-residents: 2.4
(Note: having the minimum GPA does not ensure acceptance)
- ♦ It is recommended that you complete at least 30 transferable units by the time of application
