

**CALIFORNIA STATE UNIVERSITY (CSU)  
GENERAL EDUCATION CERTIFICATION COURSE PATTERN  
2008-2009**

Each candidate for the bachelor's degree from a CSU institution shall complete a pattern of General Education courses, which total a minimum of 48 units. Chaffey College may certify a maximum of 39 semester units toward meeting this requirement; the remaining 9 semester units must be completed at the upper division level.

Full general education certification from Chaffey College requires a minimum of 39 units distributed as follows:

- Area A—9 units required
- Area B, C and D—A minimum of 9 units is required in each area
- Area E—3 units required

**Courses in Area A1, A2, A3, and B4 must be completed with a "C" or better:**

*Each course may be used in only one area of CSUGE certification*

### PREPARATION FOR TRANSFER TO THE CALIFORNIA STATE UNIVERSITY

Chaffey College offers programs of courses, which parallel the first two years (lower division), in four-year colleges and universities. Because requirements vary among collegiate institutions, it is advantageous for students to choose the college or university to which they plan to transfer as early in their educational career as possible. The student should concentrate on meeting general education requirements and lower-division major requirements while attending the community college. Such information for the various institutions is available on-line [www.assist.org](http://www.assist.org) in the Chaffey College Counseling Center or Transfer Center. In addition, the student is advised to refer to the catalog of the chosen transfer college. Each student who is interested in transferring to a four-year college or university is urged to be aware of dates and procedures in filing the application for admission. The application form for the state colleges and universities can be completed on-line at [www.csumentor.edu](http://www.csumentor.edu). You may also apply for financial aid on-line.

Meeting state requirements in U.S. History and U.S. Constitution/State and Local Government are not required to complete CSUGE or to transfer to a CSU. These requirements must be met before graduation from a CSU and may be met at Chaffey College by successful completion of PS 1 or 11 and HIST 17 or 18. Chaffey College will allow these courses to be counted in Area D on the CSUGE pattern. Since these are lower division courses, students are strongly encouraged to complete this requirement at the community college.

#### ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS TO CSU FOR THE TRANSFER STUDENT

All CSU campuses have the same admissions requirements for transfer students. Students are eligible to transfer if they:

- (1) Were eligible for the CSU as a freshman (eligibility based on high school collegiate preparatory subjects, grade point average, and ACT or SAT composite score) and have maintained a 2.0 grade point average in college work.
- OR**
- (2) Have completed 60 transferable semester units with a 2.0 grade point average including a minimum of 30 semester units from the General Education Certification Course pattern List. The 30 units in General Education must be completed with a "C" or better in each course and must be chosen from Areas, A, B, C, and D. Included must be courses from A1, A2, A3, and B4.

#### TRANSFERABILITY OF COURSES

Courses transferable to the CSU are marked "Transfer Credit: CSU" in the Chaffey College catalog. The general rule for course numbers is as follows:

#### GENERAL UNIT REQUIREMENTS

Listed below are significant semester unit requirements transfer students should be aware of in planning their transfer programs.

- 60 units -- Minimum unit requirement for admission to CSU for students not admissible from high school.
- 60 units -- Units required for Junior level standing.
- 70 units -- Maximum units transferable from community college to CSU toward degree.
- 120 units -- Minimum units required for baccalaureate degree (four-year college degree).

All students who graduate from a CSU are required to complete certain general education requirements. General Education courses are meant to acquaint student with broad areas of study such as English, social sciences mathematics, sciences, humanities, and the like, which enable the students to better understand and meet their responsibilities in society and physical world. The distribution of general education courses is as follows:
