



Dual Admission Agreement Between California State University, San Bernardino and Chaffey College

California State University, San Bernardino (CSUSB) and Chaffey College have entered into a Dual Admissions Agreement for the mutual benefit of both institutions and their students. Dual admission refers to instances in which a community college student committed to attending CSUSB is granted admission concurrently upon the condition that the student completes all lower division requirements and achieves full eligibility.

Eligibility Requirements

All matriculated Chaffey College students are eligible to apply; no specific unit or course requirements are required to initiate a Dual Admissions Agreement

Application Process

- Complete a Dual Admissions Agreement form and return it to the Transfer Center
- Meet with a Chaffey counselor to develop and education plan
- Schedule an appointment to meet the CSUSB representative in the Transfer Center
- Complete the requirements specified on the agreement
- Apply for admission to CSUSB for the term indicated during the appropriate filing period
- Get ready to transfer!

Student benefits for participating in the dual admissions program include:

- Provisional admission to CSUSB; all stated commitments, student must meet all stated commitments, GPA minimum and prerequisites
- Waiver of CSUSB admissions application fee (currently \$60)
- A stronger connection with both Chaffey and CSUSB through regular contacts, ongoing transfer advising and support from both institutions to clarify requirements and streamline the transfer process
- Opportunities to visit CSUSB and to participate in campus programs prior to actual residency
- Full access to CSUSB campus library, athletic events and other student programs at the same rate assessed to other CSUSB (health services, disabled student services and membership organizations/activities are excluded)
- Cross enrollment opportunities at CSUSB for one course per term
- Early contact from CSUSB major department
