Completion of all the requirements in the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) will permit a student to transfer from a community college to a campus in either the California State University (CSU) or University of California (UC) system without the need, after transfer, to take additional lower-division, general education courses to satisfy campus general education. Depending on a student's major and field of interest, the student may find it advantageous to take courses fulfilling either the CSU's general education requirements or those of the UC campus or college to which the student plans to transfer.

Courses used for certification must be completed with grades of "C" or better (C- grades are not acceptable) and be a minimum of 3 semester/4-5 quarter units. A course can not be certified unless it was on the list during the year when it was taken by the student. Students entering in Fall 2008 must follow the 2008-2009, or later, IGETC requirements.

Partial IGETC certification is allowed with a maximum of two courses missing, which must be completed after transfer. Areas 1 and 2 completed to meet minimum transfer admissions requirements. Partial certification acknowledging a deficiency in Area 1 and/or Area 2 may also indicate a student does not meet the minimum transfer requirements.
