

UC Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG) Program Fall 2010

Seven UC campuses offer guaranteed admission to California community college students who meet specific requirements. Through the TAG program, you can receive early review of your academic record, early admission notification and specific guidance on major preparation and general education coursework. Students do not have to participate in TAG to be considered for admission; non-TAG students should apply for admission during November, 2009.

To pursue a TAG for fall 2010, you should:

- review the information below;
- complete the attached form with your counselor's assistance;
- submit the TAG form to your chosen campus per the notes below;
- once your TAG is approved, fulfill all remaining coursework and GPA requirements designated in your TAG agreement; and
- you must apply for admission to UC between November 1 and 30, 2009.

TAG filing dates: Filing deadline is October 31
Qualifications: No minimum qualifications are required to begin work on a UCSB TAG. The only requirements are for what needs to be complete at the time of admission. See www.assist.org for requirements. Go to "agreements between UCSB and a community college" the TAG descriptions are at the top of the "by major" drop-down list.

International students: Yes, if all college work was done in the U. S.
College/major limitations: TAGS are available for the College of Letters and Science and College of Engineering; not for the College of Creative Studies.

Submission information: Students have the option to submit a TAG form to UCSB. If you choose not to submit a form, you will still be guaranteed admission providing you meet the TAG requirements and apply for fall admission. A student who does submit a TAG form will receive a written confirmation along with a copy of the TAG criteria.

TAG filing dates: August 1-October 15, 2009
Qualifications: Complete at least 30 transferable units with a minimum 3.0 GPA

International students: Yes, if all college work was done in the United States
College/major limitations: TAG is for admission to the campus only.
Submission information: Complete TAG form with your counselor and submit to Jenny Dannelley in the Transfer Center who will send it to Santa Cruz
