



Procedure for Internet Use

When using Chaffey College computer systems, all users are required to abide by the rules of this Procedure and to use the system in an ethical and lawful manner. **By using Chaffey College computer systems, users agree that they will comply with these procedures.** Use of any and all of Chaffey College computer systems for any of the following purposes is strictly prohibited.

COPYRIGHT INFRINGEMENT

Computer software protected by copyright is not to be copied from, into, or by using campus computing facilities, except as permitted by law or by the contract with the owner of the copyright.

DEFAMATION- LIBEL/SLANDER

Creation or transmission of any false statement which tends to cause injury to one's reputation is strictly prohibited.

OBSCENE MATERIAL

Creating, transmitting, uploading, or downloading obscene material is a strictly prohibited use of Chaffey College computer systems. Obscene material includes, but is not limited to, lewd, lascivious, or filthy books, pamphlets, pictures, films, papers, letters, writings, prints, silhouettes, drawings, figures, images, recordings, or any other matter of indecent or immoral character. Any user violating this provision may be subject to applicable criminal and civil penalties.

COMMERCIAL USE

Commercial use of Chaffey College computer systems is prohibited.

SYSTEM PERFORMANCE

No one should deliberately attempt to degrade the performance of the computer system or to deprive authorized personal of resources or access to any Chaffey College computer system.
